It usually connects the device to other networks or devices through a dedicated high bandwidth wire of fiber optic connection. Base stations typically have a transceiver, capable of sending and receiving wireless signals;.

Base stations use antennas mounted on cell towers to send and receive radio signals to and from mobile devices within their coverage area. Signal Transmission and Reception Base stations use antennas mounted on cell towers to send and receive radio signals to and from mobile devices within their coverage area. What is a base station antenna?

Base station antennas are also known as cell site antennas and cellular antennas, and they are typically mounted on a tower or rooftop and connected to a base station through coaxial cables. Base station antennas are available in different shapes and sizes and can be either omnidirectional antennas or directional antennas.

How does a base station communicate with a client device?

Generally, if client devices wanted to communicate to each other, they would communicate both directly with the base station and do so by routing all traffic through it for transmission to another device. Base stations in cellular telephone networks are more commonly referred to as cell towers.
