China solar power to battery in Belgium



Overview

'Europe's largest' energy storage pilot project at an industrial site, combining 2MWp of rooftop solar with a total of 4.2MWh of energy storage across a lithium-ion battery system and two flow batteries has been inaugurated in Belgium. Is solar power breaking a new record in Belgium?

With a 23% increase in installed capacity, solar is breaking many records. Renewable generation in Belgium hit a new record, accounting for 29.8% of the electricity mix (compared to 28.2% in 2023). Gas-fired generation hit an all-time low, making up 17.6% of the generation mix (compared to 25.2% in 2023 and 26.9% in 2022).

Why is Belgium allowing plug-in solar panels & batteries?

Belgium's move to allow plug-in solar panels and batteries reflects its growing commitment to renewable energy. By the end of 2023, Belgium's installed solar capacity had surpassed 10 GW. Analysts estimate that an additional 337 MW of new solar capacity was added in the first half of 2024.

How much power does Belgium produce from solar panels?

In Belgium, power production from solar panels already exceeded the 5,000 megawatt (MW) mark several times this year. This is as much as five large nuclear reactors: the current Belgian nuclear power park can still supply a maximum of just under 4,000 megawatts of power.

Where is the battery energy storage project located in Belgium?

Once completed, the four-hour battery energy storage project will operate under a 15-year contract with Elia, Belgium's electricity grid operator, and be located next to Engie's gas power plant in Vilvoorde. From pv magazine ESS News site.

What percentage of Belgium's Electricity is renewable?

Renewable generation in Belgium hit a new record, accounting for 29.8% of

the electricity mix (compared to 28.2% in 2023). Gas-fired generation hit an all-time low, making up 17.6% of the generation mix (compared to 25.2% in 2023 and 26.9% in 2022). The share of nuclear in the electricity mix fell for the fourth consecutive year.

How much solar capacity will be added in Belgium in 2024?

Analysts estimate that an additional 337 MW of new solar capacity was added in the first half of 2024. Despite a relatively stable residential market, this regulatory change is expected to stimulate further growth in solar adoption, thereby supporting Belgium's climate and energy goals.
