**Does the installation of a

Overview

Do you need planning permission to mount equipment on a building?

Landlords and tenants should now be aware that when operators request permission to mount equipment on their buildings, the size and composition of the equipment should be meticulously checked in order to see whether planning permission is required and whether the Code applies.

What is a radio base station erection?

An erection of structure on the roof of a building to support a radio base station (base station) in the form of an equipment cabinet of not more than 1.5 metre (m) (length) x 1m (width) x 2.3m (height) is a Class I minor works.

Do you need permission to install an antenna on a house?

If the antenna is mounted on the house, much will depend on how big it is and how it is attached. If it is judged not to result in a 'material alteration to the appearance of the building' it does not need permission. Any free-standing mast or pole more than 3 metres high needs permission; and more than 2.5m if it's within 2m of the boundary.

Do radio masts need planning permission?

In addition because they were within 20 metres of the highway express, planning permission was required from the Council. As a result of the case any series of radio antennae mounted on top of a building will constitute "radio masts" and as such require planning permission.

Can a telecommunications mast be placed on a property?

Getting permission to position a telecommunications mast on a property was, until fairly recently, straightforward. Planning permission was rarely required as masts and other apparatus fell within what was called "permitted development". In December 2017 a new Code became law.

Do I need planning permission if I have an antenna?

Unfortunately Yes – antennas rarely protect and enhance the conservation area or cause no harm to the setting of the listed building (which are the tests the Council apply); and so obtaining planning permission will be much more difficult.
