How big is the Addis Ababa communication base station





Overview

Ethiopia's government-owned operator Ethio Telecom (ET) has launched a 5G mobile phone service in the capital Addis Ababa. With temporary spectrum approval its strategic partner Huawei has built six mobile base stations with a view to expanding to 150 regional sites in the next year.

According to Reuters, new entrants to the market have stimulated greater competitive activity and galvanised the national carrier into action. ET is facing competition.

Speaking at the launch event Ethio Telecom CEO Frehiwot Tamru said: "The 5G service is [to be] launched in selected places in Addis Ababa." In the coming 12.

In June 2021 the Ethiopian government launched a tendering process to sell off a 40% stake in Ethio Telecom to private investors. In March 2022, the government.

With a population of 110 million Ethiopia has much potential as a developing economy but it sold only one of two full-service recon licences on offer in May.

How many people in Addis Ababa watch Addis TV?

Addis Television, also known as ETV2, can be seen by about three million potential viewers within a 30 km radius of Addis Ababa. The channel is operated by the Addis Ababa Mass Media Agency and broadcasts mainly in Amharic.

Who controls the media in Addis Ababa?

In Addis Ababa, nearly all radio and TV stations are owned by the government or interests close to the ruling EPRDF party. Newspapers have limited circulation outside major cities, and most are also owned by the government or EPRDF-aligned interests.

What is the data-transfer limit for a 2 mbps ADSL line in Addis Ababa?

In Addis Ababa, some of the educated elite take advantage of mobile internet access. In September 2011, Ethio Telecom charged about 1,100 birr (US\$65) per month for a 2 mbps ADSL line with a 6 gigabyte data-transfer limit. All the same, Ethio Telecom is planning to expand its ADSL network and mobile-data network.
