# How much does it cost to assemble an outdoor power box



## Overview

---

The cost to install an outdoor outlet is \$180 to \$350 on average, depending on the location, the home's wiring conditions, and whether the outlet requires adding a new circuit. Electricians charge \$100 to \$175 to replace an existing outdoor outlet. All outlets installed outside must be GFCI.

Installing a new outdoor outlet costs \$180 to \$350, including the unit itself, a weatherproof cover, and the electrician's labor. In comparison.

The cost to replace an outdoor outlet is \$100 to \$175. Replacing an outlet takes only 10 to 15 minutes, but most electricians charge one-hour minimum rate plus a \$75 to \$125 trip fee. In comparison, indoor outlet replacement costs \$80 to \$200, depending on.

Before hiring an outlet installer to put in an outdoor outlet, be sure to: 1. Get three in-person estimates to compare. 2. Browse their reviews on HomeGuide and Google. 3. Hire a licensed, bonded, and insured company that has been established for 5+ years. 4. Avoid hiring.

The basic cost to Install an Outdoor Receptacle is \$267 - \$398 per receptacle in July 2025, but can vary significantly with site conditions and options. How much does it cost to install an outdoor outlet?

Electricians charge \$50 to \$130 per hour for labor to install an outdoor outlet. Labor costs increase for difficult-to-access locations or if the electrician must run new wiring from the main electrical panel to the outlet's location. The following factors affect the cost for an electrician to install an outdoor outlet:.

How much does a new electrical box cost?

Adding new outlets to increase your home's electrical load without making the necessary infrastructure upgrades could cause electrical overload. When adding a new electrical box, costs range from \$125 to \$175. However, special pricing may apply for complex installations that can bring the cost up to \$300.

How much does it cost to install an outdoor receptacle?

The basic cost to Install an Outdoor Receptacle is \$228 - \$338 per receptacle in April 2024, but can vary significantly with site conditions and options. Are outdoor electrical boxes necessary?

Yes, outdoor electrical boxes are essential for outdoor outlets, lawn tools, and lighting installations. To ensure safe operation: Use a weatherproof outlet cover. It prevents rain and debris from damaging the outdoor electrical outlet. Install a GFCI outlet. Required by building codes for all outdoor receptacles. Follow local codes.

An outdoor electrical box is often referred to as a weatherproof outlet box, junction box, or exterior outlet box. These boxes are designed to house electrical wiring, receptacles, and circuit breakers, protecting them from moisture, debris, and damage. There are three common types: Surface-mounted boxes.

How long does it take to install an outdoor outlet?

Installing an outdoor outlet takes 1 to 4 hours on average, depending on if the electrician can tap in interior outlet on the opposite wall or instead must run new conduit inside the walls or along the home's exterior to connect the new outlet box to the main electrical panel.
