Overview

What is Monrovia Station?

Monrovia Station is part of the Foothill Gold Line from Pasadena to Azusa. It was completed on time and on budget on September 23, 2015, and turned over to Metro. Passenger service began on March 5, 2016. The 11.5-mile, six-station extension was completed.

Is there parking at the Monrovia Station?

The Monrovia station has a 350-space parking facility. Although directly adjacent to the historic Santa Fe Depot, parking at the depot is not included. The city of Monrovia intends to redevelop the depot as part of their Station Square Transit Village development.

Is electricity available in Monrovia?

Neither water nor electricity is commercially available in Liberia, including the capital of Monrovia. Most hotels have utilities available, but not always on a 24-hour basis.

The Foothill Gold Line, a six-station extension, broke ground on June 26, 2010 and was completed on September 23, 2015.
