# Solar powered portable outlet in Uzbekistan







#### **Overview**

What type of plug is used in Uzbekistan?

Type F - Used in almost all European countries and Russia. Also known as the Schuko plug. Plugs of type C and E will also fit in a type F socket. If you're not sure whether the outlets and plugs used in your country are the same as in Uzbekistan, you can use the tool at the top of this page to check if you need a travel adapter.

Are there electrical outlets in Uzbekistan?

No, the electrical outlets in Uzbekistan are different from those in the United States. In Uzbekistan electrical outlets of types C & F are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Uzbekistan?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Uzbekistan are of types C & F (see images).

What voltage is used in Uzbekistan?

Voltage used in Uzbekistan is 220V and the electrical frequency is 50Hz. (more details after you choose where are you plugs from.) Select your departure country for a detailed report of adapters, plugs and handling advise for electronics abroad. Are your plugs from United States of America?

Do I need a travel adapter in Uzbekistan?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Uzbekistan are of types C & F (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. However, you may still need a voltage converter if the voltage is different.

Are electronic devices compatible with Uzbekistan?



Before you travel, check the information below to make sure your electronic devices are compatible with the outlet type and voltage. Uzbekistan uses outlet types C, F at a voltage of 220V and a frequency of 50 Hz. Can you use a phone charger in Uzbekistan?

Chargers for iPhones, Android phones and other smartphones or cell phones are usually dual voltage, so you can use them all over the world. However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Uzbekistan outlet. Uzbekistan uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C & F (see images).
