Overview

What happens if the ups power goes off?

"After 9 minutes of both power failure and output off, the UPS becomes "brain dead" and stops powering the Network Management Card so it can no longer be remotely commanded. Once power returns, the UPS will leave the "brain dead" state and resume charging the battery."

Should I turn off my ups when not in use?

If you plan to not use your UPS for a longer period, such as several days, it is best to turn it off. This is because the battery will continue to discharge even when the UPS is not in use, and this can cause its lifespan to shorten. Turning off your UPS when not in use can have several benefits, including: 1. Reduced Energy Consumption.

What that second point means is you can turn the output off, disconnect the power plug, and the UPS will turn off after nine minutes. For transport or storage, SmartUPSes have a battery disconnect that should be pulled. The battery will discharge faster if not disconnected, even when the UPS is

completely off.
