Prince Albert II of Monaco presents the White Paper on Monaco's Energy Transition The Principality of Monaco is certainly not taking its environmental responsibilities lightly and has set itself a target of a 50% cut in GHG emissions (from 1990 levels) by the year 2030.

How many pumps are there in Monaco?

Today there are over 80 pumps fully operational in Monaco, including at the Grimaldi Forum, the Oceanographic Museum, the Rainier III Auditorium and the Société des Bains de Mer (SBM) buildings. Not one to rest on their laurels, plans are already well underway to develop more systems in the Condamine and Larvotto Districts.
