Can I use power plugs in Pakistan?

Select your country of residence, to check the compatibility of your power plugs in Pakistan. In Pakistan, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type C and type D are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. For more information, select the country you live in at the top of this page. We don't sell power plug adapters.

What type of power sockets are available in Pakistan?

The power sockets in Pakistan are of type C and D. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter in Pakistan.

Do I need a power adapter in Pakistan?

The standard voltage in Pakistan is 230V, and the frequency is 50Hz. Devices from countries with different voltage standards, like the United States (120V), may require a voltage converter in addition to a plug adapter. Do You Need a Power Adapter in Pakistan?

Whether you'll need a power adapter depends on the type of plug your devices use.

What type of electrical outlet does Pakistan use?

Pakistan primarily uses Type C and Type D electrical outlets. These types are common in various parts of Asia, Europe, and Africa. Also known as the standard "Euro" plug, Type C outlets have two round pins. Has three round pins in a triangular pattern, used in India and some African countries.

What voltage is used in Pakistan?

Voltage used in Pakistan is 220V and the electrical frequency is 60Hz. (more details after you choose where are you plugs from.) Select your departure

Do I need a travel adapter to plug a charger into Pakistan?

However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Pakistan outlet. Pakistan uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C & D (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter.
